

Town of Elk Mound Plan Commission Meeting Minutes

4/9/2018

Chairman Kevin Gilbertson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting notice was posted at the Elk Mound Town Hall, the Elk Mound Post Office and Independence State Bank and the Website. All of the plan commission board members were present. The meeting was called for the purpose of reviewing a CSM for Jean Burger and for other business.

The Burger CSM was reviewed by the board. Brian Jenson was present at the meeting to voice his concern over his adjacent property being leased for hunting. Hunters cannot fire their guns within 100 yards of a building. Rodney Rhude made a motion to recommend the CSM to the town board. Don Schley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jeff Miller was present at the meeting and had a question concerning selling used cars at Steele Towne. The Town Board informed him that he would have to get the proper licenses from the state to sell more than 5 cars per year. He was already operating out of Steele Towne so the Town of Elk Mound did not have to issue any further permits.

Dina Babb had questions about putting up signs for Vino Cappuccino. The Town of Elk Mound is not zoned so the Town Board does not have to issue any permits for the signs. Vino Cappuccino has to follow all state regulations concerning the state highways that they are on. This is to include the right a ways and the cloverleaf exits. It was also mentioned that they call Dunn Energy for any utility lines that may be in the way.

Don Schley made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Marvin Michels seconded the motion.

Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
